




- The second biggest university and the largest technical university in Finland

TKK Library


- Main library: 55 employees

- 23 departmental libraries: 35 employees
















New students

- Library part in the 'Orientation course for new students'
- Compulsory for all no credits
- A one-hour lecture and exercises for two hours in the library
- A good first impression of the library, how to find course books and where to find more information
- · New students coming later get a short info



Bachelor seminar

- · All students have to do this
- Lower university degree is new gives motivation
- Piloting by library from now on on departments' responsibility
- Lectures and exercises included in the seminar to support the making of the bachelor
- The library is responsible for the training of information search and making references



Master studies: methodology of science

- Has to be 5 cr courses
- A new course is being planned in cooperation with 'Teaching and learning development' and 'Language centre'
- Includes scientific information retrieval, epublishing, copyright issues and writing in English



Postgraduate level

- Tailored training for doctoral schools
